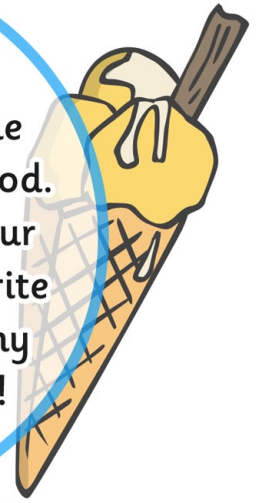


The Gruffalo Home Learning Challenge

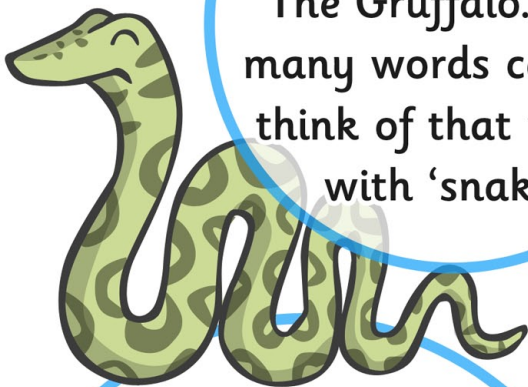
Make up your own imaginary creature. You could draw a picture or make a model of it.

There are lots of rhyming words in The Gruffalo. How many words can you think of that rhyme with 'snake'?



Use the Internet or a non-fiction book to find out an interesting fact about one of the animals in the story. It could be a fact about an owl, a mouse, a snake or a fox. Remember to share your fact with the group.



The mouse found 5 nuts on Monday and 4 nuts on Tuesday. How many nuts did he find altogether? Use your fingers or draw a picture to help you work out the answer.



The Gruffalo story was set in the forest. Draw a picture of another story you know that is set in a forest.
