<p>James is having a birthday party. He has invited 30 friends to his party and wants to make sure he will have enough cake to give to them. If a large cake can be cut into 10 pieces, how many cakes would be need to buy?</p> <p>Show your working out.</p>	<p>Sally and her mum are baking cakes for a bake sale. They are making 6 cakes. Each cakes needs 4 eggs to make it. How many eggs does Sally and her mum need to buy?</p>	<p>Thomas loves collecting football cards. He has a book that he puts them in after he has collected them. Each page holds 10 footballs and there are 12 pages in the book. How many football cards would Thomas need to collect to fill the book?</p>
<p>Jessica and her friend Molly are counting the balloons at her birthday party. On one wall there are 12 balloons and on the other there are 3 times that amount. How many balloons are on the other wall?</p>	<p>Challenge</p> <p>Miss Beamish is organising a party for Holly Class. There are 32 children in her class and she buys them all a chocolate lollipop each. If lollipops come in packs of 5, how many packs will she need to buy? Will there be any left over?</p>	<p>Challenge</p> <p>Miss Muddassir is baking cookies for all 45 year 2's at Park Way. She follows the recipe which makes 10 cookies. How many times will she have to follow the recipe to ensure all 45 children have a cookie? Will any be left over?</p>
