This year, we were fortunate to be in two suites at the O2!

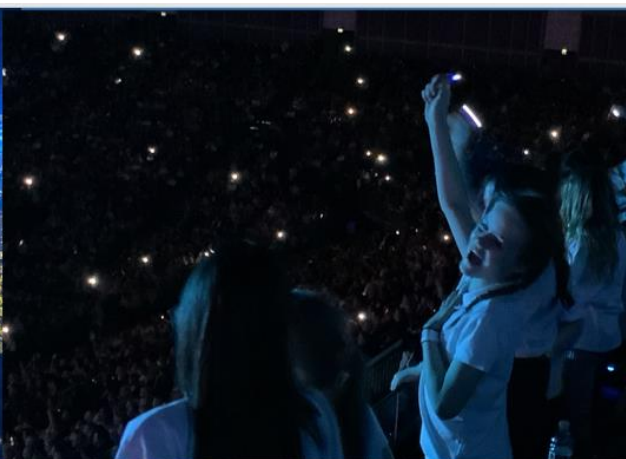
