We return to school on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> February - have a lovely half term!

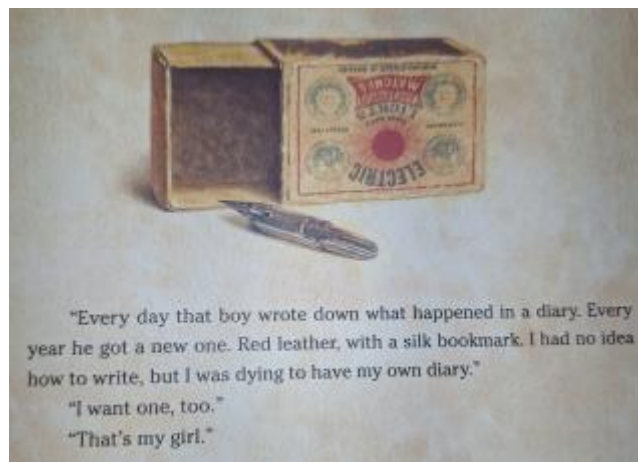
Please remember we have a staff training day on 28<sup>th</sup> and the school will be closed.

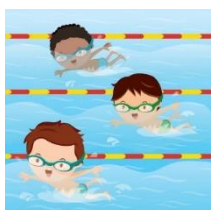
